## Overview of the Industries Department

Maharashtra is one of the leading industrial states in India. Industries play a vital role in the overall development of the State. Progressive and forward-looking policies of the Industries Department have significantly contributed to Maharashtra's economic growth.

The Industries Department plays a central role in promoting efficient and inclusive industrial development across the State. While strengthening Maharashtra's position as a leading industrial hub in India, the Department focuses on providing rapid growth opportunities for micro, small, medium, and large industries, balanced regional development, and generation of high-quality employment.

The industrial ecosystem includes the Directorate of Industries, Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation (MIDC), MAITRI Single Window System, Maharashtra State Small Industries Development Corporation (MSSIDC), Maharashtra State Khadi & Village Industries Board (MSKVIB), and Maharashtra Centre for Entrepreneurship Development (MCED). These institutions support industrial land and infrastructure, utilities, raw material linkages, market development and export readiness, technology upgradation, quality certification, skill development, and investor facilitation.

Administratively, the Department functions through seven major offices and maintains statewide field presence through 25 District Industries Centres (DICs), supported by various Boards, Corporations, and allied institutions. Together, they translate policy into action, implement State and Central Government schemes, and coordinate with departments and local authorities for timely facilitation.

Each DIC acts as a single-point interface for industries at the district level, providing guidance on land and approvals, assisting MSMEs and startups with registrations, incentives and credit linkages, supporting cluster and market development initiatives, implementing capacity-building and skill programmes, and offering a structured grievance redressal mechanism.
